

Treat yourself to touch of local artistic colour

IF you're interested in touching up on some local art this weekend don't miss the last opportunity to visit the exhibition currently on display at Nautilus Beach Resort.

Life of Colour is the fifth exhibition by local artist Jeffrey Baker and the display has become somewhat of a tourist attraction, with many visitors attending the exhibition over the past month.

The exhibition is the largest display of work that Jeffrey has display and it is an explosion of colour, featuring over 45 original art works, including a special display of new large material that is part of Jeffrey's Limited Edition Original Prints.

A lot has been happening for the artist lately, with his home studio, The Jeffrey Baker Studio Gallery, opening this year and fast becoming a popular cultural attraction. It's certainly worth a visit.

Much of his work has been commissioned, with one particularly impressive display currently a highlight in the foyer of the Coffs Harbour Health Campus.

The work of Jeffrey Baker reflects designs and it is also interpreting art that suits varied themes, surroundings, colours and atmospheres.

Jeffrey's original art works are represented in business, corporate and numerous private collections, both in Australia and overseas.

He was also commissioned to paint a large canvas to 'celebrate a new millennium of sport' for the Inside Sport publication 'Total Recall'.

Jeffrey's paintings are continually changing he describes them as a fascinating view of contemporary land and seascapes with surreal concepts.

He uses a full palette of colour, producing a feast of contemporary design in modern Australia paintings.

Life of Colour has been on display at the resort since December 30 and it will finish this Sunday. The display is open daily from 10.30am to 6pm.
